The form requires a disclosure of real property (excluding your home), investments other than retirement, certain gifts you may have received, and other financial disclosures. Form 700 is filed by the City Council, all Commissioners, and many City staff members.
- Ethics Training – All City Commissioners are required to complete a two-hour Ethics Training course once every two years. The Certificate of Completion is kept on file with the City Clerk.
