

The Los Angeles County Department of Public Works operates and maintains the flood control facility Las Lomas basin in the City of Duarte. During the recent storm, a significant amount of sediment and debris has eroded into the basin from the hillsides burned by the recent Fish Fire. To restore the basin's storage capacity and ability to protect downstream residents and property, the Department needs to remove the material.

The hauling operation will be Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. (Weather permitting). Hauling will also continue on Saturdays and possibly Sundays from 9 AM to 5 PM (Weather permitting). The project may last for approximately 4 weeks*. The material will be transported along the route as shown on the attached haul route map. The County disposal site is in the City of Duarte near Westdale Road and Sunnydale Drive. The hauling operations have been coordinated with the City of Duarte.
