

# Flood Protection Sediment Hauling

## NOTICE

A strong winter storm is expected to reach the Los Angeles County Region as early as Thursday evening, with significant rain expected in the post Fish Fire Burn Area through the weekend. To restore Maddock Debris Basin's ability to protect downstream residents and property, LA County Public Works will perform an emergency 24-hour-a-day operation of hauling sediment and debris from the basin, located in the City of Duarte, to Manning Pit in the City of Irwindale.

## TRUCK HAUL ROUTE

Trucks will enter/leave Maddock Debris Basin at the corner of Sunnydale Drive and Westvale Road and follow the route shown on the attached map. The sediment will be taken to a disposal site located near Arrow Highway and Vincent Avenue in the City of Irwindale.

## HOURS/DAY

Trucks are scheduled to begin hauling sediment 24 HOURS A DAY on Wednesday, February 15, 2017, at 6:00 am and continue through February 17, 2017, at 6:00 pm (weather permitting). This emergency operation is to restore capacity in advance of the forecasted storm on February 17, 2017.

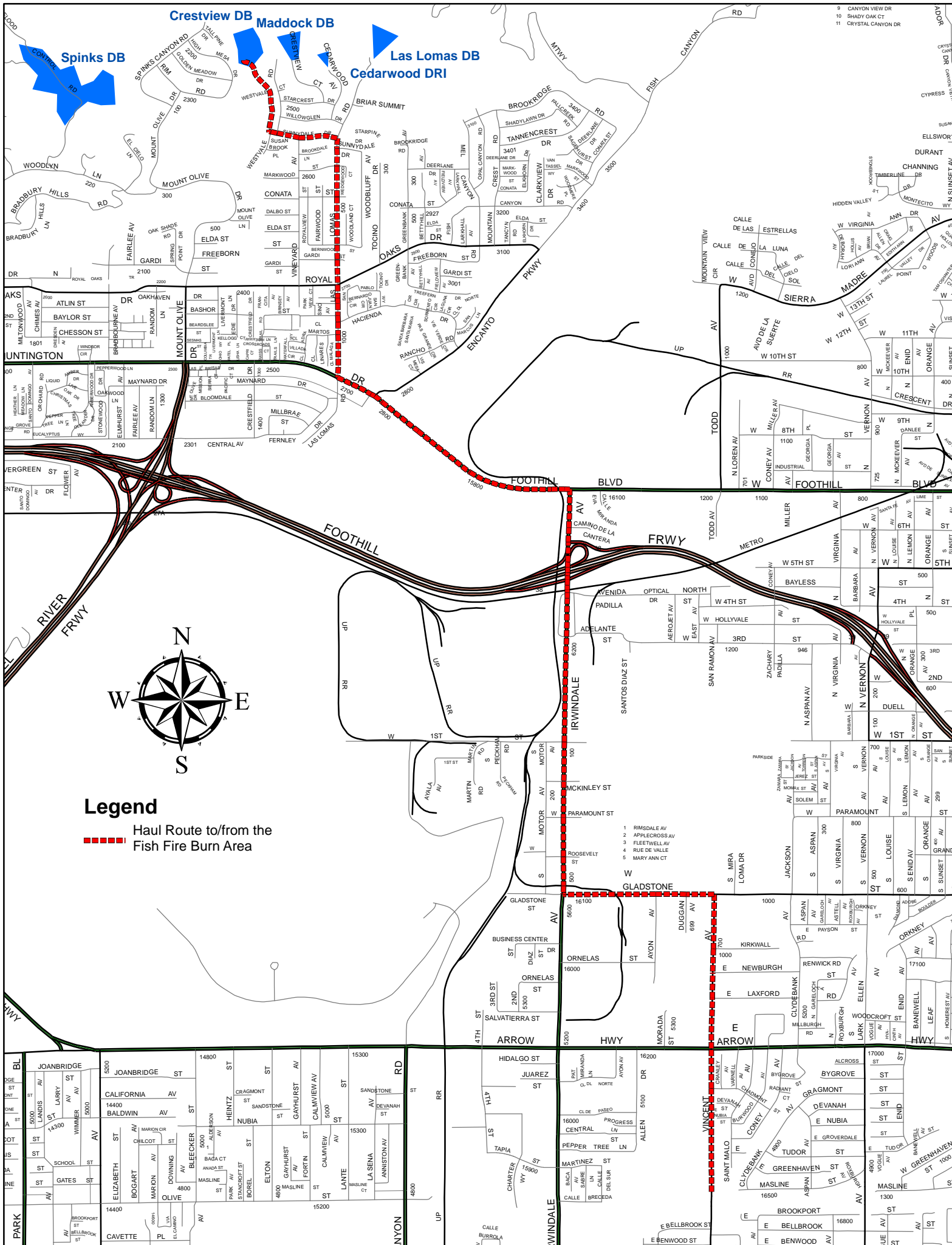
