ITEMS FROM STAFF

Director Brian Villalobos informed Commissioners that part one crimes are down 17.5% in the City. Robberies are down 38%, Burglaries are down 29%, Larceeny/Thefts are down 14.5%, and stolen vehicles are down 33%. He also reported that no major traffic issues have been reported since school is now back in session. Furthermore, he reported that National Night Out went very well. It was not as well attended as they had hoped, but staff will work on attracting more residents to this event in the future. Lastly, he informed Commissioners that next Tuesday he will take the fee resolution for RV parking permits to Council that was recommended by this Commission. Implementation of this new RV parking permit ordinance will take place after Labor Day weekend and one month of warning notices will be given to residents before citations will be issued.

ITEMS FROM COMMISSIONERS

Commissioner Calderon reported to Staff that a Male/Hispanic, in his mid-30's was looking underneath cars on Bloomdale Street and Maynard Drive in front of Andres Duarte School approximately 2 weeks ago. Commissioner Calderon suspects he might have been a local transient.

Commissioner Frye stated she has noticed a lot of comments on nextdoor.com regarding the homeless population in the City. She inquired as to what the update is with the upcoming riverbed clearance.

Commissioner Hernandez-None


