



City of Duarte Launches New Website

The City of Duarte is pleased to announce the launch of the new City website. The new redesign was developed with considerable input from residents who requested features to enhance access to the information and tools they need.

Using the San Gabriel mountains as a backdrop and integrating the city colors of blue and gold, the new website is sleek, easy to use, mobile friendly, and home to the resources residents need. Residents can easily navigate through the website to learn about paying a citation, how to apply for permits or a business license, read the latest edition of City News, or access City Council meeting materials and information.

On the desktop version of the website, residents can search by category and activity for answers to specific questions such as "I want to apply for a city job."



Moving down the screen on your desktop, the "My Duarte" function allows you to look up residential addresses to identify your District, Councilmember, Mayor, and trash & street sweeping days.



Click through the different tabs on the homescreen to view the latest city news, special events, and meetings.



The website redesign was a community effort. The City utilized FlashVote, an online surveying tool, to connect with residents on what they desire the most from the website. Based on the results, the public requested to update frequently used features such as registering for recreation classes, locating pool hours, and accessing City Council meeting recordings, making them easier to find. Additionally, Council and residents expressed the desire to improve the search engine feature. With this feedback, the website homepage was updated so residents and visitors can quickly access current news, event information, meeting agendas, and much more.

Council also suggested improved accessibility for residents to find contact information for City departments and department heads. Now, each department portal hosts corresponding contact information to allow for residents to get in touch with the representatives that can help.

The website redesign will continue to be a work in progress with Council and community input at the forefront. You can now provide feedback using the "Report" feature listed on each department page, allowing for feedback on what can be included or improved upon on each page. This is an added value as we want our residents to be a part of the new website and allow them to voice how we can better provide access to the resources they need.

Food Scraps to Go in the Green Cart Starting September 1

It's about to be a lot easier being green. Now, Duarte residents can put food scraps — including meat, bones, and plate scrapings— directly in the green curbside cart to be recycled with their yard trimmings.

With the greater convenience of recycling food waste comes a big reduction in harm to the climate. When food scraps go into the landfill, they break down and produce methane, a greenhouse gas 84 times more potent than carbon dioxide. But when the scraps go into the green cart, they end up as valuable renewable organic waste products such as compost instead.

Materials Recovery Facilities (MRF) in Southern and Central California have been composting food scraps for restaurants and other businesses for nearly a decade. The MRF utilized by the City's franchise waste hauler, Burrtec Waste Industries, currently processes more than 80,000 tons of organic material each year; that number is expected to rise with the addition of residential food scraps. It's an easy and impactful action every person can take to improve climate change.

This means that starting now, nearly all food scraps except liquids and raw meat can go into the green cart for curbside pickup:

- · Meat, fish, bones, and shells
- Cheese and other solid dairy products
- Bread, pasta, pastry, and other grains
- Coffee grounds and tea bags
- Fruits and vegetables

All food scraps must be unpackaged. No metal, wire, glass, or plastic should be included. **Do not place food scraps in a plastic bag - paper bags or wrapped in newspaper are acceptable.** This small change in your regular routine just means placing your food scraps directly into your green cart instead of your trash cart – it's that simple.

A limited amount of free kitchen pails for food scraps collection will be available to residents at the Burrtec booth during the Duarte City Picnic on Saturday, September 24 from 11 AM to 3 PM at Royal Oaks Park.

Curbside food scrap collection is a collaborative effort between the City and Burrtec Waste Industries to meet the requirements of California's climate law, SB 1383, which requires jurisdictions to provide expanded organic waste collection services to residences and businesses.



Community Clean-Up and HHW Collection on November 19

On Saturday, November 19, from 8 AM – 3 PM, Duarte will hold its bi-annual free Community Clean-Up and HHW Collection for residents at both Duarte City Hall (1600 Huntington Drive) and the CS-Arts-SGV parking lot (1401 Highland Avenue).

The CS-Arts-SGV parking location will host Los Angeles County's Household Hazardous Waste & E-Waste collection event from 9 AM – 3 PM. Acceptable waste includes brake fluid, paint, paint thinner, cleanings with acid or lye, pesticides or herbicides, household batteries and car batteries, pool chemicals, motor oil, oil filters, expired pharmaceuticals, and antifreeze. They will also be collecting household electronic waste and hypodermic needles, pen needles, syringes, lancets, and intravenous needles.

Bring items in a sturdy box (preferably in their original labeled containers) and be sure not to mix items together. There is a limit of 15 gallons or 125 pounds of hazardous waste per trip.

When arriving, make sure items are in the trunk of your car or bed of your truck, as the County will not be able to remove items from the backseat. Remain in our car and bring a mask. Please note that business waste will not be accepted and



neither will explosives, ammunition, radioactive materials, trash and tires, or any type of controlled substances. More information is available at CleanLA.com or call (888) CLEAN LA.

At the City Hall Location from 8 AM – 2 PM, Burrtec Waste Services will be accepting residential bulky items to dispose. Additionally, Burrtec will take old paperwork to shred including bank statements, old pay stubs, credit card applications, and anything else with personal information that you want disposed of properly. No binders please. For compost materials, residents should bring the proper vehicle or storage container to accommodate the load. Burrtec will provide shovels. Bring your Burrtec trash bill for address verification. For more information on the clean-up and shred event, contact Burrtec at (626) 932-1558.

Mid-Year Review Neighborhood Watch Update

Property crimes in Duarte increased by 9.75% percent through June of this year compared to the same period last year. Reports concluded a 25% spike in vehicle burglaries and a 25% increase in commercial burglaries, while residential burglaries increased by over 100%. Sergeant Fiedler reported that this uptick is something we are experiencing in neighboring cities and around the county. He states that the public safety response was immediate, with various saturation patrols in critical locations, which helped curtail criminal activity. However, we want to remind you to please take proactive measures to avoid becoming a victim.

At Home:

- Always lock doors and windows and set your alarm
- · Never keep spare keys in or around your home
- Use your surveillance cameras and ensure they cover entrance and exit areas
- Ensure you have adequate exterior lighting. A motionsensitive light is recommended for backyards
- Barbecues and bicycles are best stored out of sight
- · Always lock your garden sheds and garages
- Don't allow daily deliveries of mail, newspapers, or flyers to build up while you are away. Instead, arrange with the Post Office to hold your mail or arrange for a friend or neighbor to take them regularly.

Business Owners can take the following precautions:


- Greet customers as they enter and exit the business
- Keep windows clear of displays, posters, or other items
- Only keep small amounts of cash in registers and EMPTY the register when the business is closed
- Utilize security systems, both alarms and video surveillance (make sure employees have access to footage in case of an emergency)





Duarte Teen Center


