DRIVE-THRU DOG VACCINATION & LICENSING CLINIC

SATURDAY, JUNE 17 | 8 - 10 AM | ENCANTO PARK, 777 ENCANTO PARKWAY

In cooperation with VET CARE, the Duarte Public Safety Office has scheduled the annual, low-cost Vaccination Clinic. All attendees must stay in their vehicles, no walk-ups are allowed, and no cash will be accepted, check or credit only.

Rabies vaccinations will be available for \$13 each, microchip registration for \$35, and other vaccinations will also be available upon request. Additionally, the option to purchase Duarte dog licenses will be available on-site.

Dog Licensing Fees:

One Year, unaltered \$60

One Year, spayed/neutered \$25

Senior citizens 65 years and older are eligible for one free dog license if the pet is spayed or neutered.

Avoid late fees and purchase your license by August 31, 2023. Rates, including a penalty after August 31st, are as follows:

One Year, unaltered, \$120

One Year, spayed/neutered \$85.

If you cannot make this event, you may purchase your license by mail or at Duarte City Hall or the Public Safety Office. If paying by mail, please mail the Public Safety Office, 1042 Huntington Dr. Duarte, CA 91010, the following:

Proof of rabies vaccination – expiration date cannot expire before June 30th2024

Proof of sterility - if the dog is spayed or neutered

Check or Money Order made out to City of Duarte (NO CASH)

Remember, all dogs over the age of 4 months must be vaccinated for rabies to comply with state law. With the foothills in our backyard, the chance of your dog having contact with local wildlife is great. Don't hesitate...Vaccinate!

We are excited to announce the completion of the Duarte City Hall Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Improvement project. The new upgrades will ensure residents of all abilities will have full access to City Hall to meet their civic needs. In addition to the ADA compliant upgrades, Duarte residents can also enjoy City amenities with a brand new, aesthetically enhancing look. The project is partially funded by federal Community Development Block Grant Funds, which the City has historically used for other ADA upgrades throughout the City.

Duarte residents can use the brand-new ADA features including wheelchair accessible ramps, hand railings, directional signage, and outdoor furniture. When the project launched in September 2022, significant underground utility work was completed, specifically plumbing for drainage and irrigation, and electrical work. Concrete was poured throughout the pedestrian areas and new retaining, seating, and planter walls were constructed for residents to enjoy.

NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH UPDATE

Property crimes in Duarte decreased by 19.87% in the first quarter of 2023 compared to last year. Commercial burglaries were the only issues experienced this quarter and our Duarte Sergeant is working with businesses to help prevent them.

This summer residents are encouraged to take proactive measures to avoid becoming a victim:

Home Safety Tips:

- **1.** Make sure all windows and doors are closed and locked. If possible, try adding a dowel or security bar as an added safety measure.
- **2.** Put mail and deliveries on hold, or have someone retrieve them, while you are gone. Check out the www.USPS.com website for information about putting your mail on hold.
- **3.** Install motion-sensor video doorbell or security cameras that can send you alerts or text messages.
- **4.** Set a timer on a light inside your home to give the impression someone is inside.
- **5.** Avoid discussing future vacation plans on social media. This can give would-be thieves too much information. And, try not to post vacation photos or details until you return.
- **6.** Set up a Vacation Patrol Check through the Duarte Public Safety Office. This program is a free service offered. The checks are performed by volunteers and is supplemental to your own safety and security efforts but can help deter possible thefts or damage to your property. Travel Safety Tips:

- **1.** Share your travel plans with a trusted friend or family members, including hotel and flight information in case of an emergency.
- **2.** Be friendly when you are out sightseeing; but remember not to give your personal information, your hotel room number, or travel plans to strangers.
- **3.** Keep your valuables close to you or securely locked in a hotel safe. Purses should be zipped up and worn close to the body. Try not to put loose dollars, credit cards, or your ID in your back pocket, those can easily be pick-pocketed. Use your front pockets if necessary.
- **4.** Do not hang the bags on the back of your chair. When dining out, bags, purses, or backpacks are most safe on your lap or on the floor between your legs.

If you see suspicious persons or vehicles in your neighborhood, please note the car's make/model/color or description of the person(s) and always call in ANY and ALL suspicious activity to Temple Sheriff's Station at (626) 285-7171. If you feel unsafe call 9-1-1.

Hook'd and Book'd

On April 6 th , 2023, at approximately 10 PM, Duarte patrol Deputy Ostrowski was conducting patrol checks of Encanto Parkway when he observed an older model black Chrysler 300 illegally parked in the dirt entrance to the Puente Lario walking bridge. As he approached the vehicle, he observed two passengers unloading what appeared to be groceries into a shopping cart. He contacted the driver of the illegally parked vehicle to warn/cite for the violation. As he contacted the driver and began questioning him as to why he was illegally parked, Deputy Ostrowski observed a used methamphetamine glass pipe in plain view in the vehicle's center console. Deputy Ostrowski detained the driver and had him exit the vehicle pending a narcotics investigation. Deputy Ostrowski conducted a pat down of the suspect and located a large amount of U.S. currency wrapped up in small bundles and a small digital weighing scale.

In addition to the methamphetamine pipe, U.S. Currency, and the scale, Deputy Ostrowski located a medium-sized plastic zip lock bag containing a large amount of methamphetamine in the center console adjacent to where he located the methamphetamine pipe. Due to the totality of the evidence, Deputy Ostrowski determined the suspect contained a large amount of methamphetamine to sell and arrested him for possession of narcotics for sale violation of 11378 H&S, a felony. The two passengers using the shopping cart to transport personal items into the riverbed were cited for Duarte Municipal code for illegal possession of a shopping cart.


