



## DUARTE CITY COUNCIL APPOINTS NEW CITY MANAGER BRIAN VILLALOBOS



At its regular meeting on Tuesday, May 23, 2023, the Duarte City Council appointed current Public Safety Director Brian Villalobos as its new city manager. The City Council's decision follows the appointment of current City Manager Daniel Jordan to city manager of the City of La Cañada Flintridge on May 15, 2023.

"In his 23 years of serving Duarte, Brian Villalobos has demonstrated the ability to build, cultivate, and support a culture of camaraderie and partnership, within the team and throughout the community," stated Duarte Mayor Jody Schulz. "I am proud that he will serve Duarte as the city manager and know that his dedication to our residents, staff, and community will ensure that we are able to reach our city's goals. He has built the public safety program and participated in the growth of our city for more than two decades, making him part of the fiber of our community. I am confident in his capacity to continue delivering for the residents of Duarte, as he always has, alas now from the City Manager's Office. We congratulate him on his new role."

As Duarte's Public Safety Director for 17 years, Villalobos leveraged over \$1.7 million in California Gang Reduction, Intervention and Prevention (CalGRIP) grants and his background in gang management to address the community's concerns of gang violence among youth. He emphasized gang reduction early on, helping create the Duarte Area Resource Team (DART) and A-Team, which to this day, brings together Duarte youth for leadership training, mentorship opportunities, field trips, college tours, anti-bullying guidance, and more.

The initiatives resulted in a decrease to nearly zero gang activity in the City of Duarte since 2019. Over the past 10 years, there has been over a 90% reduction in juvenile arrests. Under Villalobos' leadership, the Public Safety Department also underwent a modernization, implementing web-based tools that took the City from paper to paperless for code enforcement and applications.

"I am honored to have contributed to Duarte's evolution over the years, and to now have the opportunity as city manager to continue improving the quality of life for our residents," Villalobos commented. "Duarte has been good to me since I started as a deputy in 2000 and I've made every effort to give back to this city. I am humbled by the City Council's faith in me and look forward to bringing to fruition the goals they've set for the City."

At its regular meeting on Tuesday, June 13, 2023, the Duarte City Council appointed current Public Safety Manager Larry Breceda as its new Director of Public Safety.

In this role, Breceda will be heading up the Duarte Public Safety Department overseeing services such as animal control, code enforcement, homelessness programs, emergency preparedness and management, in addition to community safety programs such as Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) and Neighborhood Watch.

"After 21 years of service to Duarte, Larry Breceda has demonstrated his ability to make an excellent Director of Public Safety for the City of Duarte." said former Director of Public Safety and current Duarte City Manager, Brian Villalobos. "He brings a wealth of knowledge, background and passion to this new position. He has helped build the public safety program and no doubt will continue to grow our great city."

Breceda, born and raised in the City of Duarte, began his Duarte career in August 2002 while earning his business degree at California State Polytechnic University, Pomona. His degree in technology operations management with an emphasis in government helped him excel in statistics, service operations and utilizing technology to make the service industry of government more efficient.

In March 2013, Breceda began his role as Duarte's Public Safety Manager. He has established his career on leveraging technology to make processes streamline for residents and staff. As Duarte's Public Safety Manager for over a decade, Breceda found solutions by identifying inefficiencies with the department and created goals, making operations more fluid and natural in order to serve residents promptly. He has effectively managed department staff while maintaining a team environment, emphasizing team problem solving for the betterment of the community.

#### MID-YEAR REPORT

The mid-year report indicates a substantial decrease in crime compared to the previous year. The data reveals an impressive 22.84% overall reduction in Part 1 Crimes. Notably, Robbery experienced the most significant decline, with a remarkable drop of 37.5%. This success can be attributed to the dedicated efforts of Sergeant Fiedler and the Special Assignment Team, who conducted saturation operations in collaboration with Duarte businesses to align with crime trends.

Director of Public Safety, Larry Breceda comments, "We are having a great year. I want to congratulate the Public Safety team, especially Sergeant Fiedler, the Deputies, and, of course, our residents, that were proactive in crime prevention." While celebrating these achievements, Director Breceda emphasizes the importance of maintaining positive momentum and continuing the commendable work in ensuring public safety.

To continue this trajectory, we ask residents to remain proactive and help direct Deputies to problem areas by calling all suspicious activity. If you see suspicious persons or vehicles, please note the car make/model/color or description of the person(s) and always call Temple Sheriff's Station at (626) 285-7171. If you see a crime in progress or feel unsafe, call 9-1-1.

#### Please take proactive measures to avoid becoming a victim:

- Always lock your vehicle, take your keys, and set your alarm
- Never keep spare keys in or under your car or around your home
- Maintain a clean car and do not keep valuables in it, or the trunk
- Park in well-lit, heavily populated areas
- Make copies of your registration and insurance, and keep them in your wallet or purse. Then remove all forms of identification from your vehicle
- Lock up windows and doors before you leave the house.

  If you have an alarm system or cameras, use them, even if you leave for a short period of time
- Anyone who engages in door-to-door solicitation must obtain a permit. Always call Temple Sheriff's Station and report solicitors

## DART Duarte Area Resource Team

#### **Receives International Recognition**

The Duarte Area Resource Team (DART) program will be honored by ICMA, the International City/County Management Association, with a Local Government Excellence Award at the 2023 ICMA Annual Conference this fall. ICMA's Community Health & Safety Awards recognize the local government programs or processes that demonstrate innovation, excellence, and success in the community's safety, health, and/or wellness, including enhancement in the quality of life for more vulnerable populations.

DART is an evidence-based crime prevention and intervention program focusing on youth development programming for residents 13-19 years old. In the last 13 years, with state grant funding, the Duarte Public Safety Department has worked to improve and expand the delivery of this youth mentoring program. DART underwent a three-year mixed method independent evaluation by Azusa Pacific University, which found that the program had a direct and positive impact on youth and the larger community.



"I am extremely proud of the DART program and of the fact that it is being recognized internationally! I have the privilege of being a product of DART," said Councilmember Cesar Garcia. "I served as DART Vice President in 2010 and can honestly say that this program fueled my passion for serving others. I dedicated over a thousand hours of service, and throughout my time in DART, I could network and make connections that have opened doors for me. DART is really "one of a kind," and it wouldn't be what it is without the staff that has dedicated years to making it what it is & who have made genuine connections with the students".



The DART program team comprises the City of Duarte Crime Prevention Specialist, a Los Angeles County School Resource Sheriff's Deputy, and college interns. In close partnership with Duarte Unified School District, the program keeps youth active through community service. All participants are rewarded with fun monthly activities like hiking, movies, theme parks, college trips, or even camping with their mentors.

#### **Kat Morozova**



As Duarte's Animal Control Officer, Kat canvasses our city, checking for dog licensing and rabies vaccinations. She also patrols neighborhoods for stray, injured, and abandoned animals and cares for distressed wildlife. In addition, what she enjoys the most is reuniting our four-legged friends with their families.

Kat double majored at UC Irvine in Criminology and Psychology. She has over 12 years of experience working with both domestic and wild animals in animal care facilities, veterinary clinics, and animal control. She was an Animal Regulation Sergeant at a Humane Society in Northern California at her last assignment for three years. Her specialty was Animal Cruelty Investigation and Search and Rescue. She has collaborated with several agencies, including Fire, PD, DCFS, Fish and Wildlife, and the US Marshals. Kat is a long-distance runner, enjoys nature photography, and has been playing tennis since age six.

Kat would like to tell residents that a dog's normal temperature is 101.5 degrees; at 120 degrees, your pet can suffer from heat exhaustion and die, and at 107 degrees, brain damage occurs. The inside of a vehicle parked in 70-degree weather can reach 100 degrees in just 20 minutes. On hot days, temperatures inside parked cars can climb to 140 degrees in less than one hour. Therefore, never leave your dog in your vehicle.


