Half Year Mark vs One Year Mark Data

Half Year Mark - Data


- 39 average monthly issues reported
- Total of 236 submissions
- Photos submitted in more than half of submitted reports
- Community Development Department calls regarding issues decreased by 38%

One Year Mark - Data

- 39 average monthly issues reported
- Total of 472 submissions
- Percentage of reports that included at least one photo stabilized
- Community Development Department calls regarding issues decreased by 44%




Reported Issues Each Month





Comparison

City of Duarte – "Report an Issue"

- Launched at the end of February 2023
- No cost to develop
- Less than a month to create
- 472 total submissions
- 39 average monthly issues reported
- City Population: 21,807

 According to the Census Bureau

City of South Pasadena – Mobile Application or "App"

- Launched at the beginning of September 2022
- ~\$15,000 per year
- ~2 months to create
- ~300 total submissions
- 25 average monthly issues reported
- City Population: 25,850

 According to the Census Bureau

Commission Feedback Implemented

- QR code was created and added to outreach material
- Updated language under the Contact Information (Optional) section
- Updated completion message:
 - "Thank you for your submission. Reports will be processed Monday Thursday, between 7:30 AM 6 PM."



City Mobile App Research

City Mobile App Research

- Average time to develop app is a little over 3 months
- GOGov provides service to 25 cities in LA County
- Less than half of cities in the San Gabriel Valley region have a mobile app available
- Each city mobile app has the same components as the "Report an Issue" website feature:
 - Have an issue-reporting form
 - Provide the option to upload photos to submissions
 - Managed by city staff

Covina	49,489	~1,500	198
Monterey Park	58,554	521	220
South Pasadena	25,850	~3,000	25




City Mobile App Research

 Estimated cost to develop and maintain a Duarte mobile app is ~\$12,000 per year
