

Projected General Fund – 2024/25

GF Revenues \$23,738,400

GF Expenditures \$25,801,400

Deficit (\$ 2,063,000)

\$2M in Special Projects funds (former ARPA)



Projected General Fund - Revenues

FY 2024-25

General Fund Revenue is projected to be \$300k more than 23/24

Construction related revenues are less than recent years, but at or above historical averages

Sales Tax revenue is slightly more than recent years

Property Tax revenue is slightly more than prior year



does not include Hotel, Town Ctr north, golf course or, school

Projected General Fund - Revenues

FY 2024-25

Building Permit revenue - \$500,000

19/20 \$2.1M, 20/21 \$2.1M, 21/22 \$2.5M, 22/23 \$700k, 23/24 \$550k

5-year average prior to 19/20 = \$550k

Plan Check revenue - \$400,000

19/20 \$1.5M, 20/21 \$2M, 21/22 \$1M, 22/23 \$289k, 23/24 \$600k

5-year average prior to 19/20 = \$375k

Conservative assumptions do not include Wyndham, Twn Ctr north, or school site development

Overall General Fund Expenses are \$1.9M more than 2023/24

\$2M for first phase of Landscape Median Project funded by Special Project fund (former ARPA)

 (demo, site prep & grading = \$400k+)
 (electrical, landscaping & lighting = \$550k+)
