

DOG VACCINATION & LICENSING CLINIC

SATURDAY, JUNE 8 | 8 - 10 AM | ENCANTO PARK, 777 ENCANTO PARKWAY

In cooperation with VET CARE, the Duarte Public Safety Office has scheduled its annual, low-cost Vaccination Clinic.

Rabies vaccinations will be available for \$15 each, microchip registration for \$35, and other vaccinations will also be available upon request. Additionally, the option to purchase Duarte dog licenses will be available on-site.

Dog Licensing Fees:

One Year, unaltered \$60

One Year, spayed/neutered \$25

Senior citizens 65 years and older are eligible for one free dog license if the pet is spayed or neutered.

Avoid late fees and purchase your license by August 31, 2024. Rates, including a penalty after August 31, are as follows:

One Year, unaltered, \$120

One Year, spayed/neutered \$85.

If you cannot make this event, you may purchase your license by mail or at Duarte City Hall or the Public Safety Office. If paying by mail, please mail to the Public Safety Office, 1042 Huntington Drive, Duarte, CA 91010, the following:

Proof of rabies vaccination - expiration date cannot expire before June 30, 2025

Proof of sterility - if the dog is spayed or neutered

Check or Money Order made out to City of Duarte (NO CASH)

Remember, all dogs over the age of 4 months must be vaccinated for rabies to comply with state law. With the foothills in our backyard, the chance of your dog having contact with local wildlife is great. **Don't hesitate...Vaccinate!**







Duarte Station Residential Developments

MBK Rental Living is developing two residential projects In the Duarte Station Specific Plan area, just north of the Metro Station. Both buildings are located on Fasana Road.

Completed in 2023, Esperanza is over 95% leased. It has 344 units with floor plans that range from studios to two bedrooms. Esperanza most recently won the 2023 Commercial Real Estate Silver Award and the SBID International



Design Award. Amenities include: a rooftop recreation area with a pool, a fitness center, five outdoor courtyards with BBQs, fire pits, bocce ball, corn hole, outdoor seating and lounging, picnic tables, and fruit trees.



In addition to Esperanza, MBK Rental Living is in the process of building Solana, a 292-unit residential development. Solana is currently under construction with plans to begin leasing units by

late 2024. It will have units ranging from studios up to three bedrooms, a variety of amenities, as well as co-working space.

Metro Station Parking Lot Development

Metro Station is in the process of choosing a developer to build a parking lot on the South West corner of Highland Avenue. and Fasana Road. The plan is to construct a residential/mixed-use development, as well as a parking structure to accommodate parking for Metro Station and the new development. While it is early in the planning process, the concept plan includes 100-120 units for a mix of family and senior apartments, in addition to some commercial and office spaces facing Highland Avenue.



Pedestrian Upgrades Near Duarte Station

The Evergreen Street Sidewalk Improvements project will be completed in Summer of 2024. The upgrades to come will improve pedestrian safety and enhance mobility on Duarte's streets:

- A new sidewalk and pedestrian lighting on the northside of Evergreen Street from Highland Avenue to Brightside Avenue.
- Improvement of the pedestrian walkway between Brightside Avenue and Buena Vista Street
- A new sidewalk on the southside of Central Avenue from Duncannon Avenue to Highland Avenue.
- The widening of the sidewalk on the westside of Highland Avenue under the freeway underpass.

Westminster Gardens Expansion

Human Good, the property owner of Westminster Gardens, is proposing a major expansion to the current senior community. An EIR and specific plan amendment is now in process to allow approximately 400 additional senior living units, commercial, and office uses.



BP Charging Station

Construction is scheduled to begin on a new style of charging station at the northeast corner of Huntington Drive and Bradbourne Avenue (2107 Huntington Drive). Vacant since the early 1990's and formerly a traditional gasoline fueling station, the proposed charging station will now offer 26 parking spaces for charging. Plus, customers can pass the time at an indoor lounge complete with TVs, vending machines, electrical charging ports for personal devices, and Wi-Fi via a BP app.

This new charging station will be available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The lounge will be open from 8 AM - 10 PM, but the restroom will offer 24 hour access. All facility offerings will be self-serve, with no on-site personnel available. Access to the lounge and restrooms will be provided electronically through an app or via a code as part of the charging process. Typical charging time is between 20-30 minutes, and fees are charged to vehicles that use the dispenser.



Duarte Senior Center Receives \$10,000 Donation from HumanGood

At the regular City Council meeting on Tuesday, February 13, 2024, the Duarte Senior Center received a \$10,000 donation from HumanGood, a nonprofit organization dedicated to enhancing the quality of life for older adults.

The City of Duarte plans to use the \$10,000 donation to purchase new furniture for the Senior Center lobby and new outdoor patio furniture.

The Duarte Senior Center is open to all residents 55 years and older and is a valuable asset to the Duarte community. The Center provides opportunities for older adults to connect with vital community resources to help them remain active, healthy, and maintain a good quality of life.

Programs and services include everything from social to physical health programs, legal assistance, and meal and nutrition programs through partnerships with the YWCA and the Los Angeles Regional Food Bank. In addition, the Duarte Senior Center offers active senior programming consisting of yoga, chair volleyball, dance classes, and organized sports including senior softball and pickleball.

The Senior Center also publishes a bi-monthly newsletter that lists special events exclusive to older adults in Duarte, such as themed monthly dances, holiday related events, Bingo, and opportunities to travel together through the excursion program.

"I'm honored to present this donation," said HumanGood Representative Andrew Smith. "I commend the City for having a vibrant Senior Center and Senior Center program. We hope that with this donation the center and program will continue to be a valuable space for the City."

"HomeGood has been a wonderful partner over the years and I'm looking forward to continuing a positive partnership," said Recreation Supervisor Susie Perez. "We appreciate the donation and it's really going to help enhance the facility."

Duarte Approved the Pickleball Court Conversion at Royal Oaks Park

Did you know the number of dedicated pickleball players in the City of Duarte has almost tripled this year? Good news! The City has new pickleball courts on the way for our community to enjoy. This muchanticipated addition to the City's recreational facilities comes as a response to the voices of community members who have expressed their love for the sport.

At the regular City Council meeting on Tuesday, February 13, 2024, the Duarte City Council approved the full conversion of one existing tennis court at Royal Oaks Park (2627 Royal Oaks Drive) to two permanent pickleball courts, and to paint pickleball lines on the other tennis court side to allow it to be used as a tennis court and/or pickleball courts.

In Duarte, there has been an increase in participation for its free Senior Center pickleball program at the Duarte Sports Park (1401 Central Ave). The program has grown to a three day a week, two-hour program offered at the six temporary pickleball courts, which will continue at Royal Oaks Park even with the addition of the new courts. With the approval of the Pickleball Court Conversion at Royal Oaks Park, there will be four additional pickleball courts: two permanent and two interchangeable.

The Royal Oaks Park Courts Resurfacing project is an approved Capital Improvement Project this Fiscal Year 2023/24, which means that this conversion will have no fiscal impact.

NOVEMBER 5, 2024 ELECTION

On November 5, 2024, Duarte residents living in Districts 2, 3 and 7 will vote on their City Council representatives in addition to the Presidential election.

The Duarte City Council is comprised of seven members who are directly elected by Duarte voters. The current City Council



The Duarte City Council is comprised of seven members who are directly elected by Duarte voters. The current City Council district map was selected on April 12, 2022, following a rigorous redistricting process. The adopted map establishes 7 districts with Districts 2, 3, and 7 up for election in November 2024, and Districts 1, 4, 5, and 6 up for election in 2026. Learn more about your district by visiting the City's redistricting website.

Currently, Vinh Truong represents District 2, Jody Schulz represents District 3, and Toney Lewis represents District 7. One City Councilmember will be selected to fill the seats in each of these districts for a term of 4 years, expiring in 2028.

The Council serves as the legislative body for the City and is responsible for establishing City policies, adopting City ordinances and resolutions, holding public hearings, adopting the City's budget, and authorizing City expenditures. City Council also appoints the City Manager, City Attorney, and the members of City commissions and committees. For those interested in pursuing a City Council seat, the nomination period runs Monday, July 15, 2024 to Friday, August 9, 2024. Calling All Local Artists: Submit Your Artwork for the Duarte Utility Box Art Program

Are you interested in having your artwork displayed in the Duarte community? The City is now looking for original designs by local artists to cover four utility boxes in Duarte!

Los Angeles County-based artists aged 18 or older are encouraged to showcase their talents while promoting eye-catching public art throughout the City. This application is open to all artists: professional, amateur, and students. All approved designs will be printed on vinyl and installed on City-owned utility boxes by a third-party vendor.

The original artwork can be designed or created in any 2D medium such as graphic art, photos, or similar materials. We encourage applicants to develop designs in digital format, however, the City will also accept photographs or scans of physical art for the application.

This call for artists is part of the Utility Box Art Program, which aims to transform these metal cabinets into works of art in order to contribute to the unique character of each site location and create a more vibrant and welcoming cityscape.

Utility Box #1

- Located at the Southeast corner of Huntington Drive and Mountain Avenue.
- The theme chosen for this location is "Route 66."
- This location is the westerly gateway of the City and will be one of the first things motorists and pedestrians see as they enter the community. The utility box does not have a meter pedestal and is located within the public sidewalk.

Utility Box #2

- Located at the Southwest corner of Duarte Road and Circle Road.
- The theme chosen for this location is "Medical Health."
- This location is at the easterly entrance to the City of Hope Campus, across the street from the light rail station, and adjacent to the City's Duarte Road bike lane. The utility box will be very visible for the many staff and visitors who use light rail to commute to City of Hope, in addition to the general public. A meter pedestal accompanies the utility box and a public sidewalk surrounds them.

Utility Box #3

- Located at the Northeast corner of Fasana Road and Highland Avenue.
- The theme chosen for this location is "Transportation."
- This location is adjacent to the City's light rail station, and across the street from the Duarte Station Specific Plan the community's transit-oriented neighborhood. A 344-unit apartment building was completed in 2023, and a second, 292-unit, apartment building is slated to be completed by the end of 2024. Future uses adjacent to this box location may include additional mid-rise apartment buildings, mixed-use, and/ or hospitality. This location is located at a "T" intersection and will be very visible to eastbound Fasana Road traffic. There is a meter pedestal with this utility box, but there is no sidewalk abutting them. A bike "sharrow" lane is located on both sides of Highland Avenue.

Utility Box #4

- Located at the Southeast corner of Huntington Drive and Crestfield Drive.
- The theme for this chosen location is "Childhood."
- This utility box is located on the public sidewalk, in front of the Maryvale Early Education Center along with the easterly segment of Huntington Drive. This location will be most visible to pedestrians and many of the commuters who take Huntington Drive for their evening commute. The utility box does not have a meter pedestal and is located within the public sidewalk.

All submissions must include a Utility Box Art Program application, original artwork, and both a 200-word maximum artist statement and artwork statement. In addition to these requirements, artists can also submit a resume and one to three examples of previous artwork. Submissions for locations with both a utility box and a meter pedestal must include designs for both boxes.

Artists can submit up to two design proposals, but an artist can only have one submission chosen by the City. Artwork will be evaluated by the Arts Ad Hoc Committee and will recommend submissions to the City Council for final approval. If their work is selected, artists will be notified within one week of City Council approval.

Selected artists will be paid a \$750 stipend per each approved design chosen for those utility box locations that contain only a utility box. Selected artists will be provided an additional \$200 stipend per each approved chosen design for locations that have both a utility box and a meter pedestal. The artist will not be responsible for installing vinyl wraps.

Duarte's utility boxes will soon have a fresh new look! At its regular meeting on Tuesday, April 23, 2024, the Duarte City Council approved the Utility Box Art Program Guidelines and 2024 Call for Artists, kicking off the Utility Box Art Program.

The Utility Box Art Program was created to transform utility boxes into beautiful art pieces that recognize the unique character of the Duarte community and create spaces that people find welcoming and inclusive. The goal of this program is to not only give local and regional artists an opportunity to showcase their talents, but also to promote vibrant and memorable public art throughout Duarte that enhances the urban landscape.

The Utility Box Art Program Guidelines summarize the program's mission, objectives, and operational procedures and outline the roles and responsibilities of various stakeholders, including the Art Ad Hoc Committee, City Council, and participating artists.

The 2024 Call for Artists is a practical tool for prospective artists that outlines the application process, eligibility criteria, project themes, and submission requirements. While the guidelines provide a high-level overview of the program, the Call for Artists provides actionable steps.

In addition to the approval of the program guidelines and call for artists, the City Council approved a budget amendment of \$15,984 for Fiscal Year 24-25. This budget amendment will cover costs to the four utility box locations selected to start the program, such as vinyl wrap costs, stipends, and repairs. The final design selection is anticipated to be completed by November 2024 and the installation of the wraps are scheduled for January 2025, dependent upon vendor availability. Based on available utility boxes and funding, the City will fund three or more projects annually.

The implementation of this program comes at the recommendation of the Arts Ad Hoc Committee, which reviews, researches, and recommends public art relating to art on freeway walls and utility boxes. The Committee has been meeting once a month since November of 2023 with the main focus of establishing a Utility Box Art Program in Duarte.

After researching various cities that have implemented their own similar programs, the Art Ad Hoc Committee chose to use vinyl wraps to cover each utility box with an artist submitted design and/or artwork. Vinyl wraps were selected as the medium of choice due to several factors, including: longevity, inherent graffiti protection, and ease of maintenance. Currently, only the 17 utility boxes owned by the City are eligible for the program. City staff plans to explore partnership opportunities to expand the program to other publicly and privately owned utility box locations in the future.

City staff will oversee the Utility Art Box Program, in partnership with a third-party vendor to install the selected designs as a graffiti-resistant vinyl wrap on each box, and manage all repairs for vinyl wrapped boxes for up to three years.

Holding an Associate degree in Administration of Justice from Pasadena City College, his professional background emphasizes his commitment to upholding safety and justice.

Deputy Rivera encourages community involvement. He advocates for residents to engage in Neighborhood Watch programs and familiarize themselves with reporting procedures for suspicious activities. Emphasizing the importance of proactive community policing, he reminds residents to trust their instincts and promptly report suspicious behavior. FIREWORKS PROHIBITED

The City of Duarte will be enforcing restrictions on both "safe and sane" and illegal fireworks usage for the Fourth of July 2024. Fireworks may not be discharged on the day of July 4 or any other day of the year since the passage of Measure F in November of 2018.

Both Duarte Public Safety and the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department will have extra patrols out on the holiday and days leading up to it to ensure that restrictions are enforced. Violators of the City's fireworks restrictions may be prosecuted and receive a \$1,000 fine and/or six months in jail. The California State Fire Marshall has decreed a zero tolerance against illegal fireworks due to drought conditions.

The loud booms and bursts of fireworks can also scare dogs, cats, and critters, causing them to run away. In fact, the Fourth of July is one of the busiest days of the year for animal shelters around the country. If your pet runs away, check your neighborhood first, then contact Duarte Public Safety at (626) 357-7938 during regular operating hours, or contact the San Gabriel Valley Humane Society at (626) 286-1159.

NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH UPDATE

During the first quarter of 2024, Duarte experienced a slight uptick of 7.95% in Part 1 crimes compared to the same period last year. It's important to highlight that we've experienced a significant reduction of 15.91% in the past five years. Duarte Deputies geared up to combat this slight uptick by being more proactive. They were able to successfully apprehend a burglar, thwart a grand theft auto, and remain actively engaged in enhancing visibility in collaboration with Duarte residents and businesses.

HOOK'D & BOOK'D

While on routine patrol on March 11, 2024, Deputy Rivera exhibited keen observation in a traffic stop on Buena Vista Street and Huntington Drive. He spotted a white GMC Sonoma with multiple vehicle code violations. Without hesitation, Deputy Rivera initiated a traffic stop to address the violations and caution or cite the driver accordingly. Upon engaging with the driver, Deputy Rivera uncovered a troubling detail – the individual was operating the vehicle without a valid license and placed him in the rear seat of the patrol car.

While attending to the driver, Deputy Rivera noticed suspicious behavior from the vehicle's occupants, prompting him to call for backup from additional patrol units. Upon their timely arrival, the passengers were escorted out of the vehicle and subjected to a thorough pat-down for potential weapons.

During this procedure, the discovery of methamphetamine in the possession of two passengers marked a significant turn of events. Moreover, a search into the criminal history of the third passenger revealed an active warrant for their arrest, as he was on parole.

With the driver in custody, Deputy Rivera proceeded to conduct an inventory of the vehicle, which was to be towed due to the driver's arrest. In the process, further narcotics paraphernalia was unearthed, resulting in additional charges against the driver.

Deputy Rivera's astute handling of the situation led to the successful apprehension of four individuals. The driver faced charges of driving without a license and possession of narcotics paraphernalia. Passenger 1 was arrested for possession of narcotics and narcotics paraphernalia. Passenger 2 faced charges for possession of narcotics, while Passenger 3 was arrested for violating parole. This incident underscores the importance of proactive policing and the dedication of law enforcement officers like Deputy Rivera to ensuring public safety. 


