# Award of Contract: Royal Oaks Park Pickleball Court Conversion & Tennis Court Resurfacing Project

### Background

Back in February, the City Council approved the Parks & Recreation Commission's recommendation for a full conversion of one (1) of the existing tennis courts at Royal Oaks Park to two (2) permanent pickleball courts, and to paint pickleball lines on the remaining tennis court side to allow it to be used as both a tennis court and pickleball courts.



## **Background (continued)**

- On May 13<sup>th</sup>, the City published an invitation to bid on the Royal Oaks Park Pickleball Court Conversion and Tennis Court Resurfacing Project -24-12.
- On June 5<sup>th</sup>, the City received two (2) bids for the subject project.

#### **Bid Outcome**

Trueline Construction & Surfacing, Inc. \$116,461.35 RMS Construction \$144,450.00



#### Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends City Council:

- 1) Award the construction contract for the Royal Oaks Park Pickleball Court Conversion and Tennis Court Resurfacing Project to Trueline Construction & Surfacing, Inc., as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder in the amount of \$116,462, in addition to a ten percent contingency.
- 2) Approve a total project budget amendment of \$54,109 from the Park Improvements fund.
